New Adelphi building

- New Adelphi Building, University of Salford, Peel Park Campus, Manchester, M5 4BR
- Large building located on the roundabout next to Salford Central
- There will be members of staff located at the entrance of the building, look for the University of Salford lanyard.
- The building is sign posted and there are way points dotted all over campus

What to expect on the day

- There will be around 100 guests (maximum), a mixture of artists, academics, practitioners, students and independent researchers.
- The day will begin at 9am and end at 7pm
- New Adelphi is a well-lit building with large windows and tall ceilings. The New Adelphi Theatre is a darker room with artificial lighting and a large stage. There are multiple fold out seats around the room and a large desk at the back for sound and lighting.
- There may be music played throughout the conference, particularly during the exhibition on Thursday evening. Noise levels could be high depending on the number of people attending.
- During the panel shows, guests will use microphones. If you are noise sensitive, please let us know and we can seat you away from any speakers.

Travel to us

- We would encourage guests, where possible, to travel to us via public transport. Our Peel Park campus is centrally located and well connected via bus routes (number 50). The New Adelphi building is right next to Salford Crescent train station.
